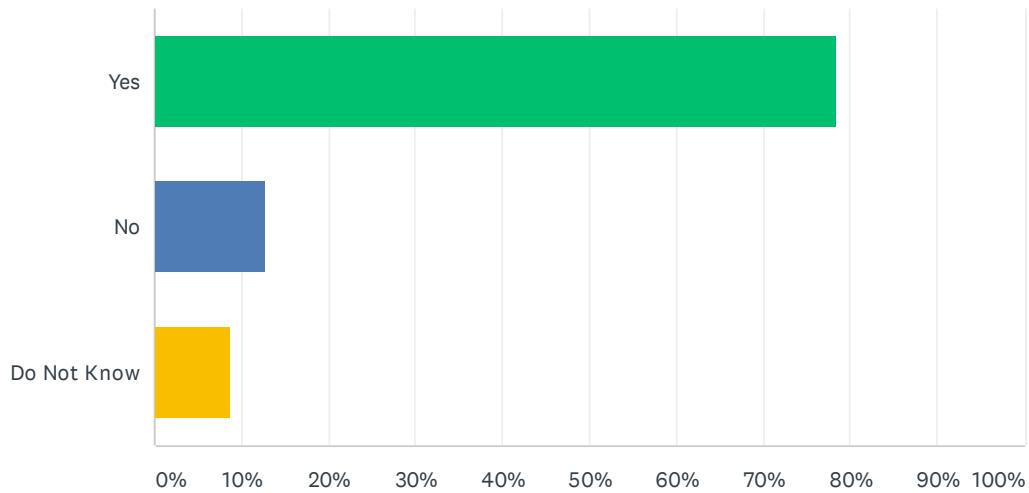

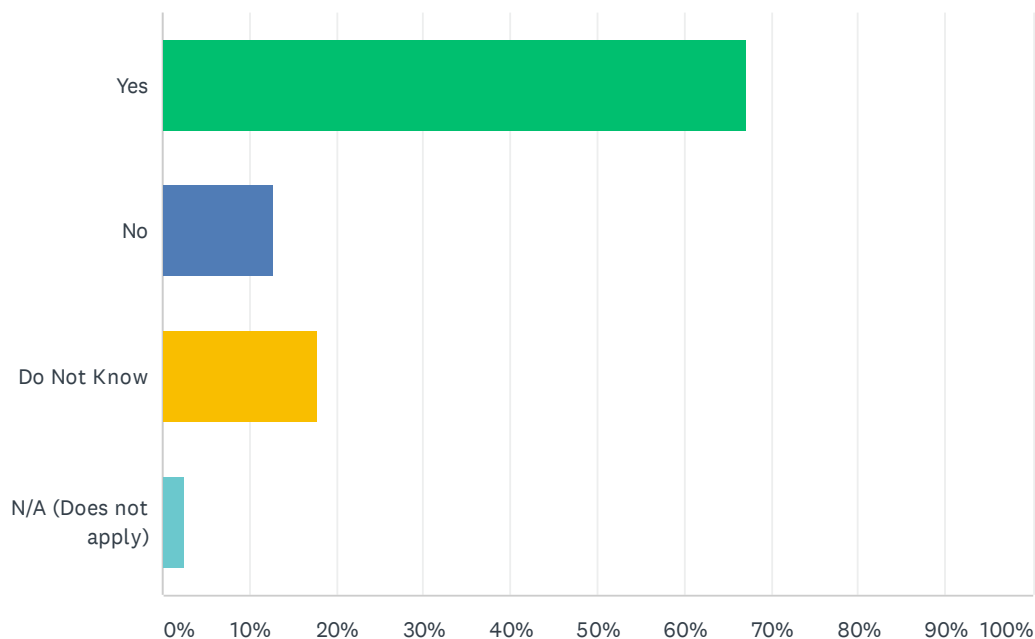

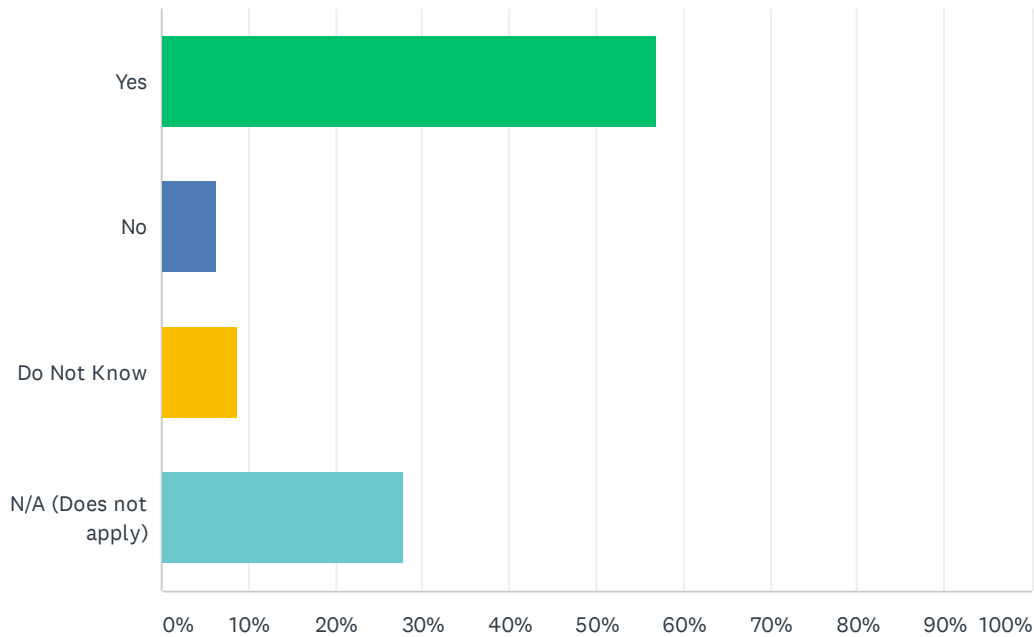

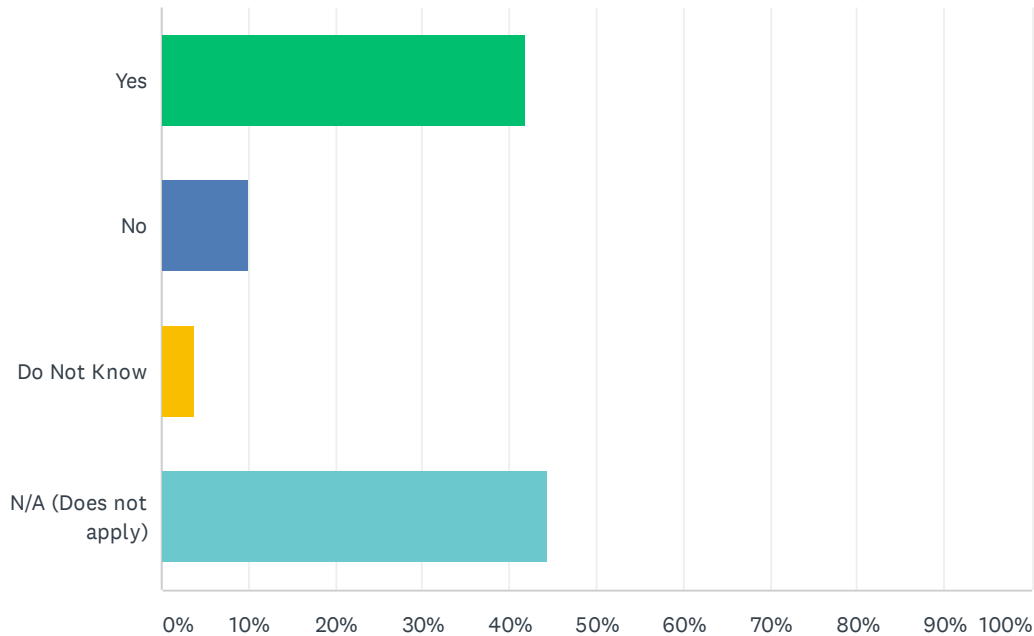

Q5 Did you receive information from your school or district about how your child scored on the state tests (most recent test scores were from 18-19 school year)?

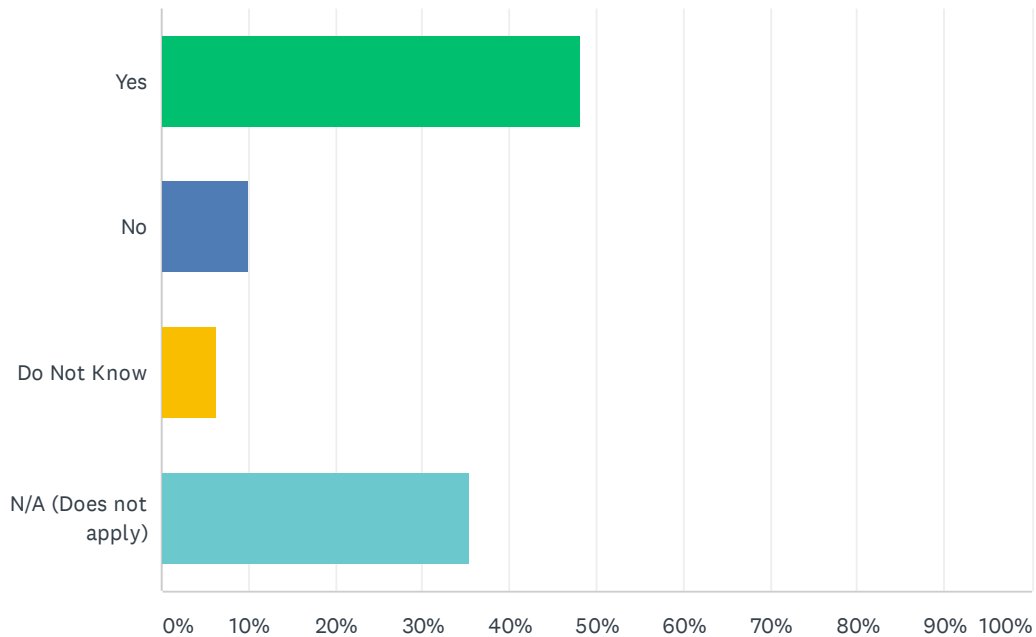

Q6 Did you receive information from your school or district about what the score on the state tests mean?

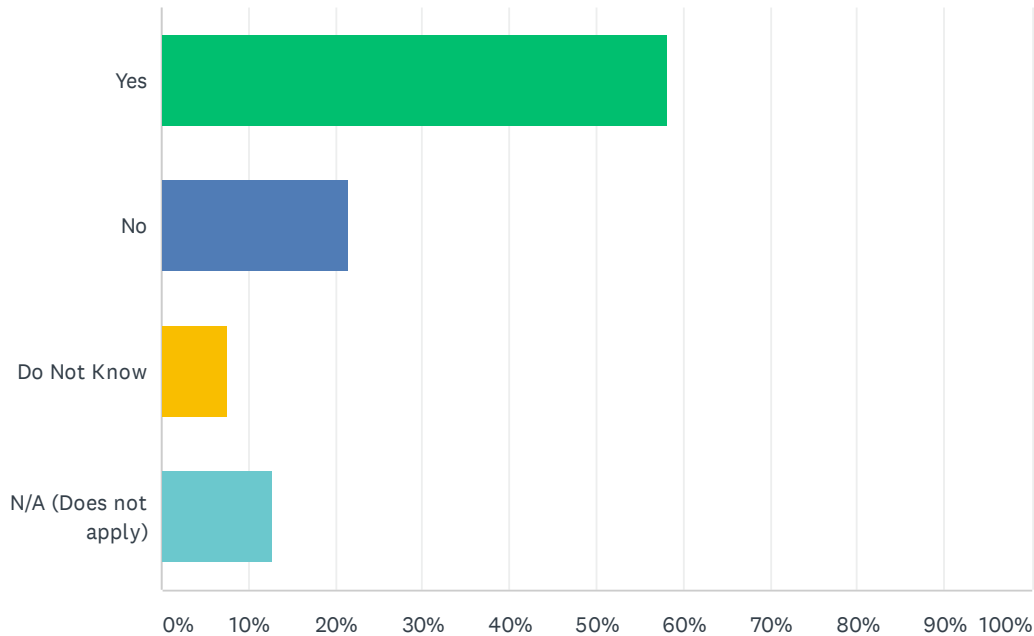

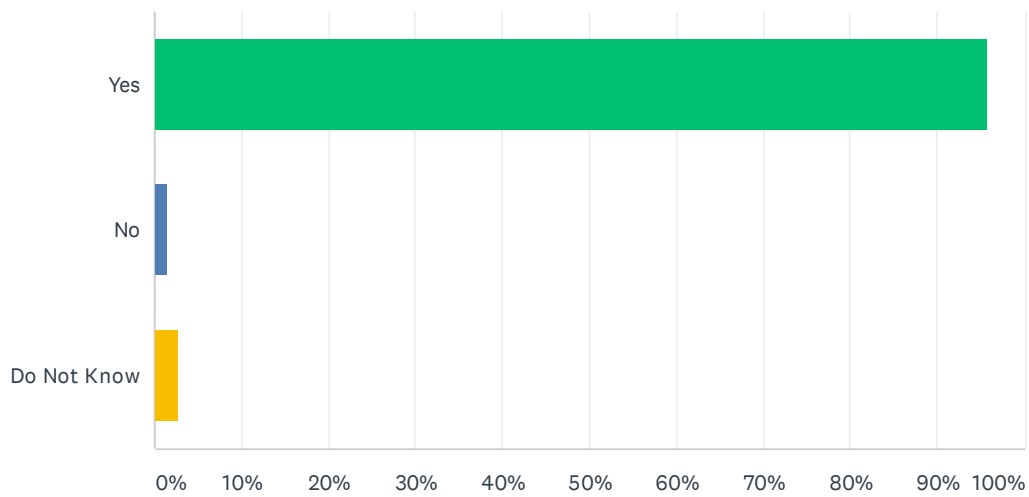

Q8 Do you feel respected by your child's school?

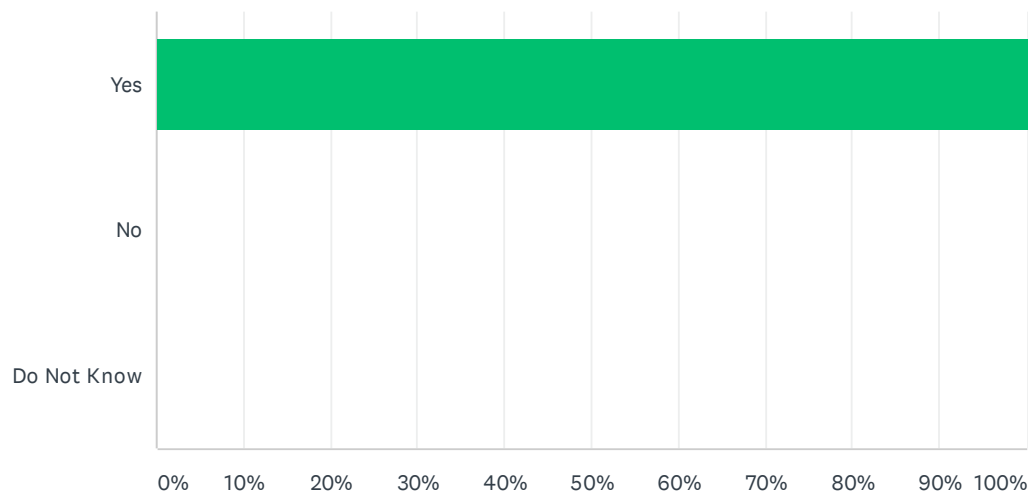

Q9 Does your child's school create a welcoming environment for parents?

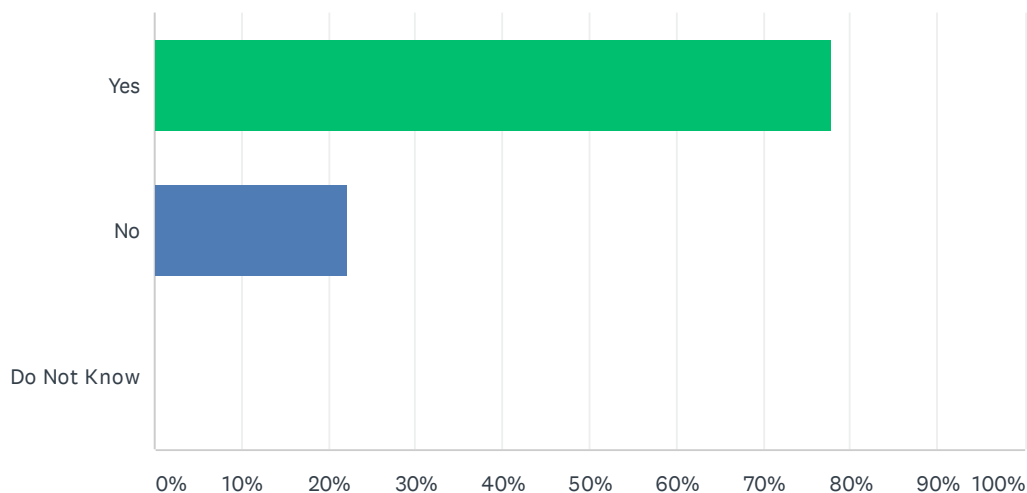

Q10 Did your child's school ask your advice on how they can best teach your child?

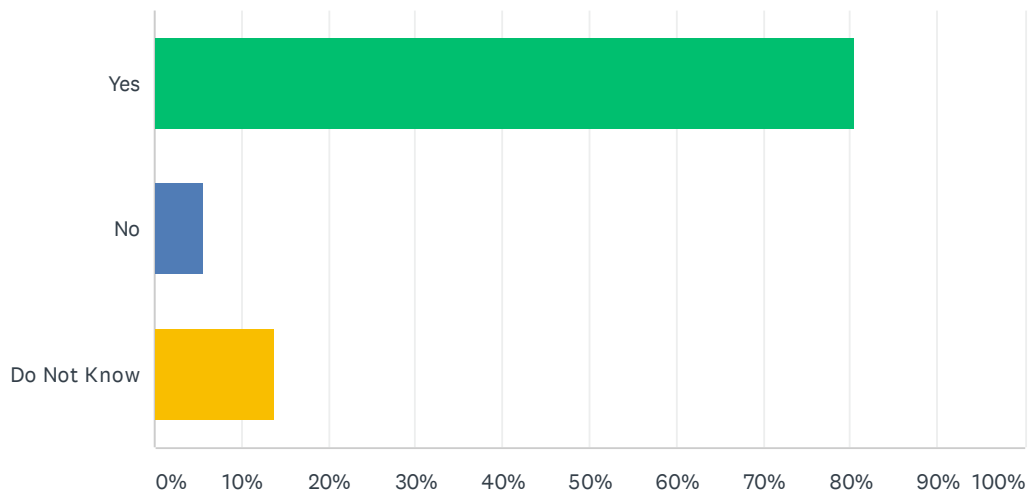

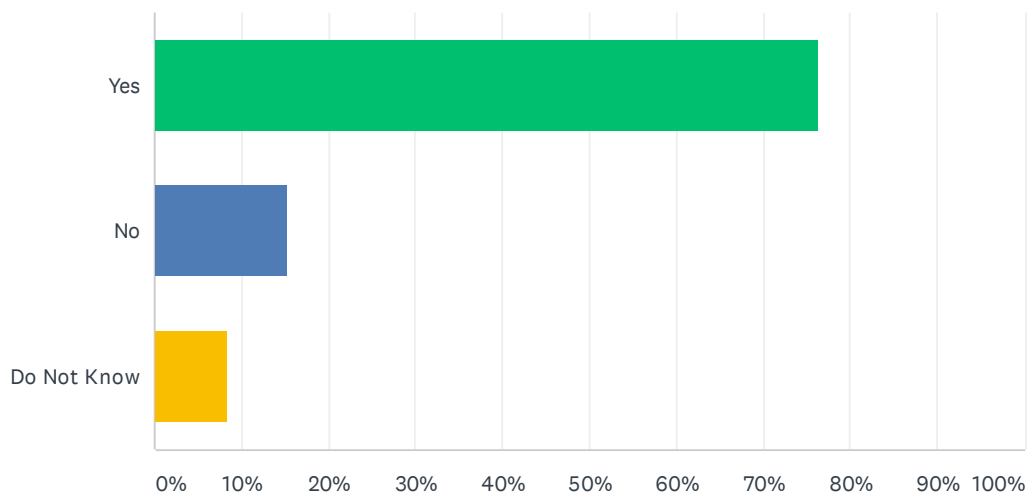

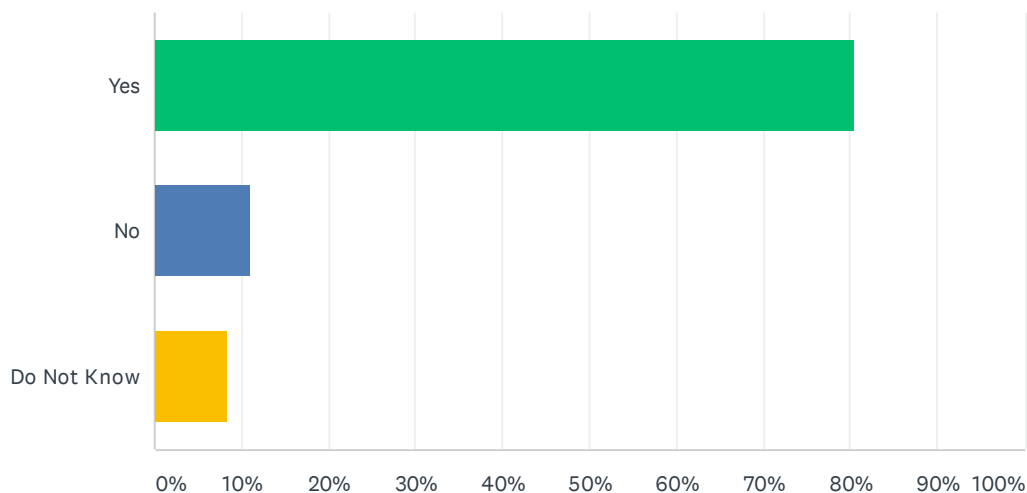

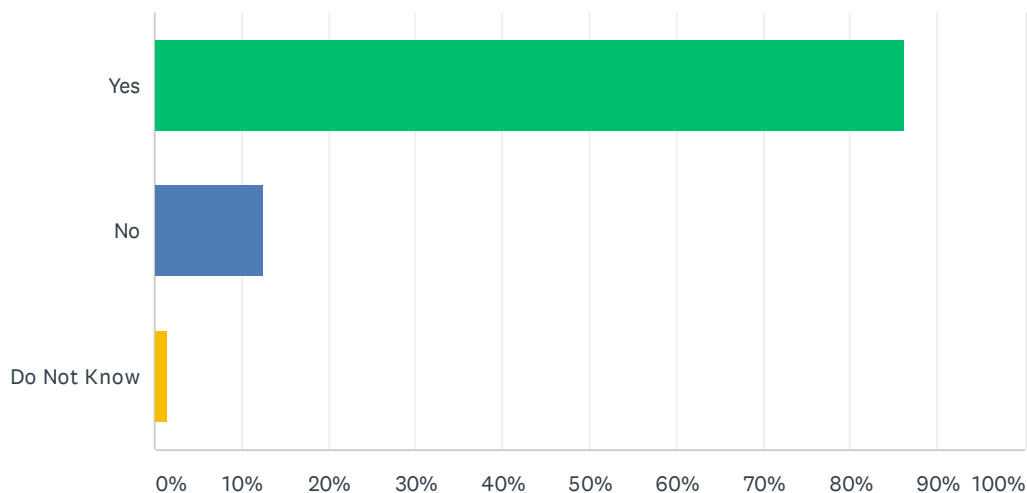

Q14 Did you receive materials to help you work with your child at home to do better in school?

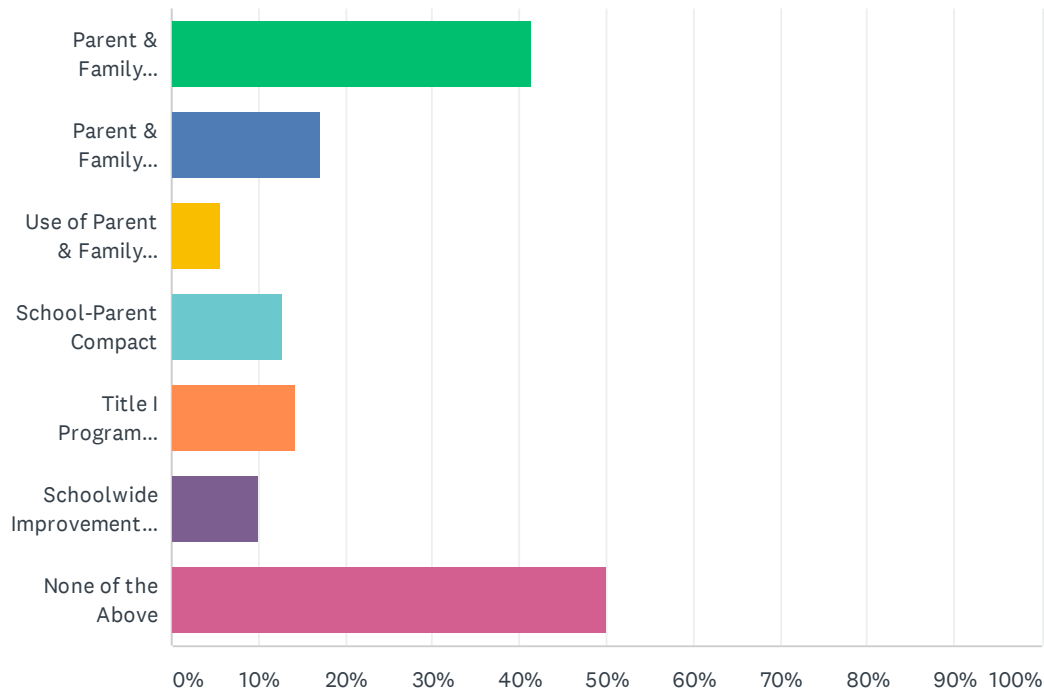

Q15 In the past year, did you participate in the development and review of the following? (choose all that apply)

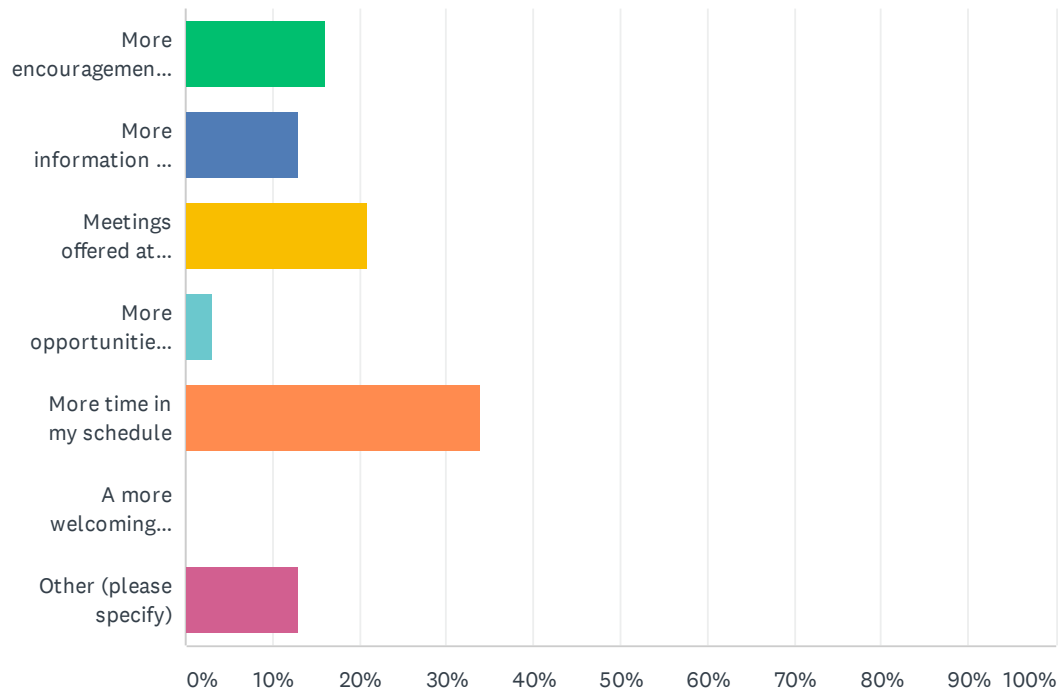

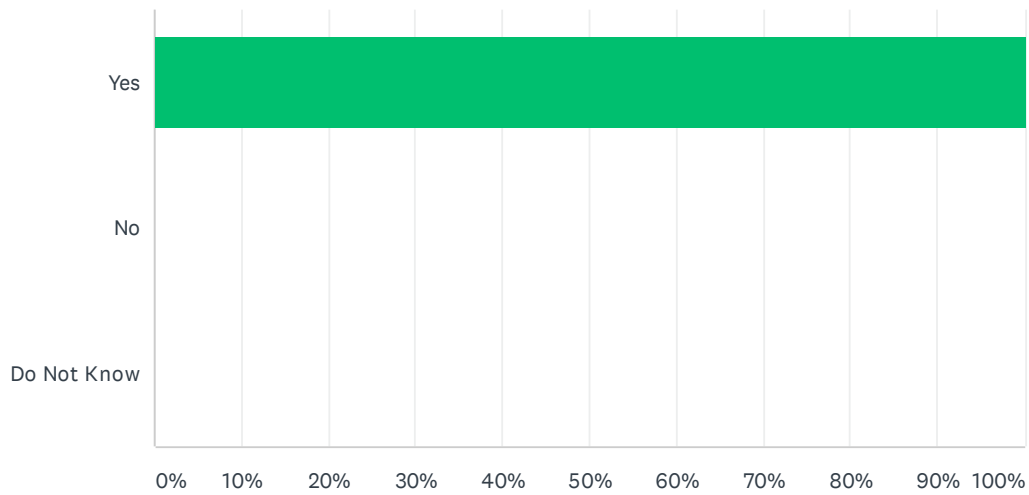

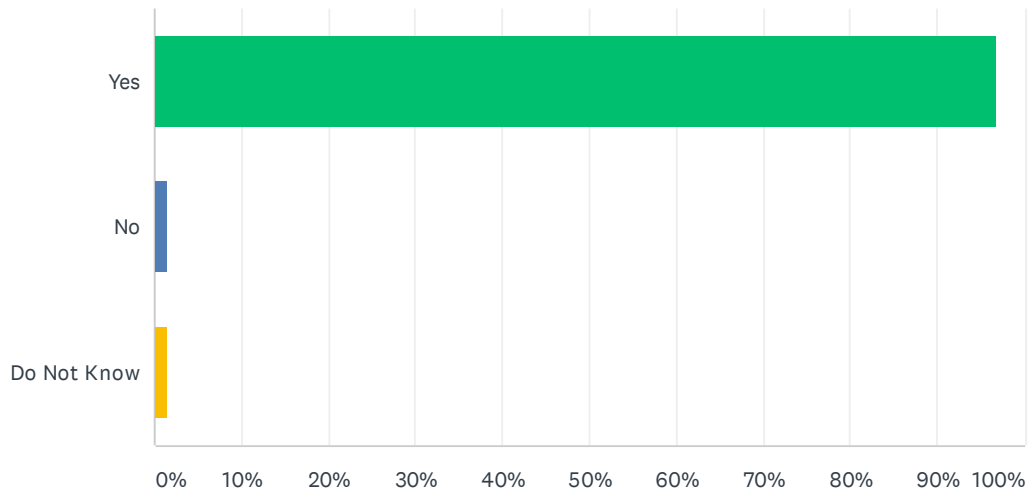

Q18 Did you feel that teachers, principals, and other school staff are willing to communicate with you?

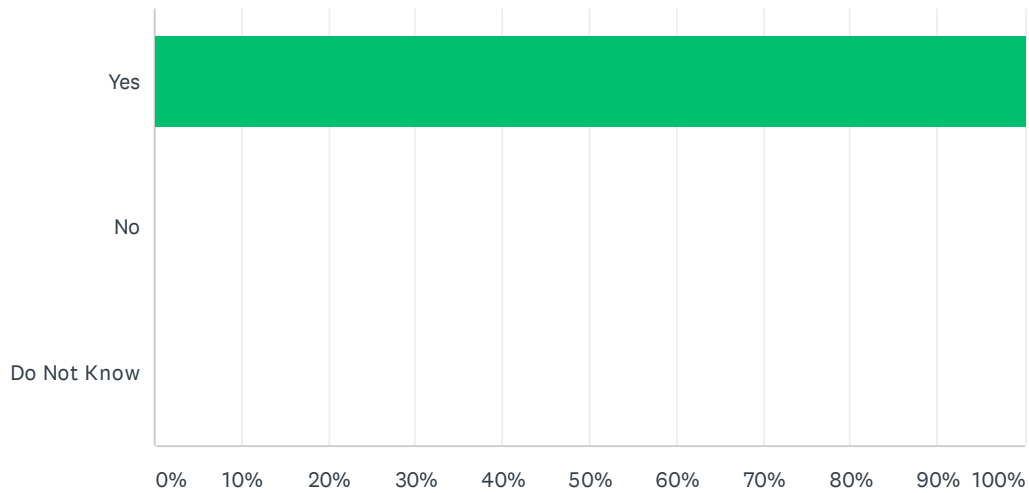

Q19 Was information from your child's school easy to understand and in a language you understand?

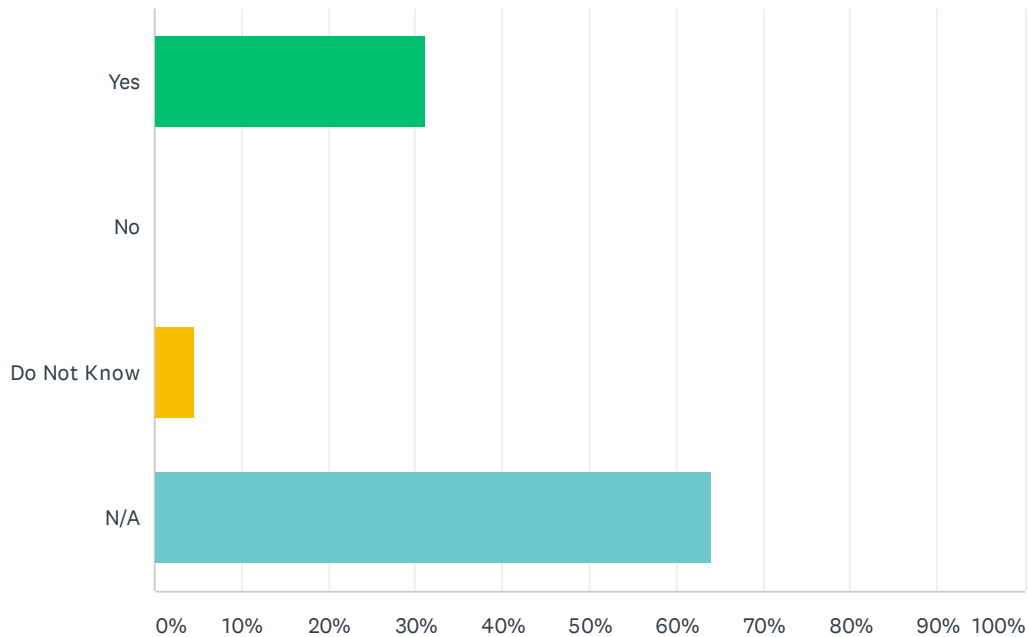

Q20 If needed, were translators available and able to help you at parent meetings and other school activities?

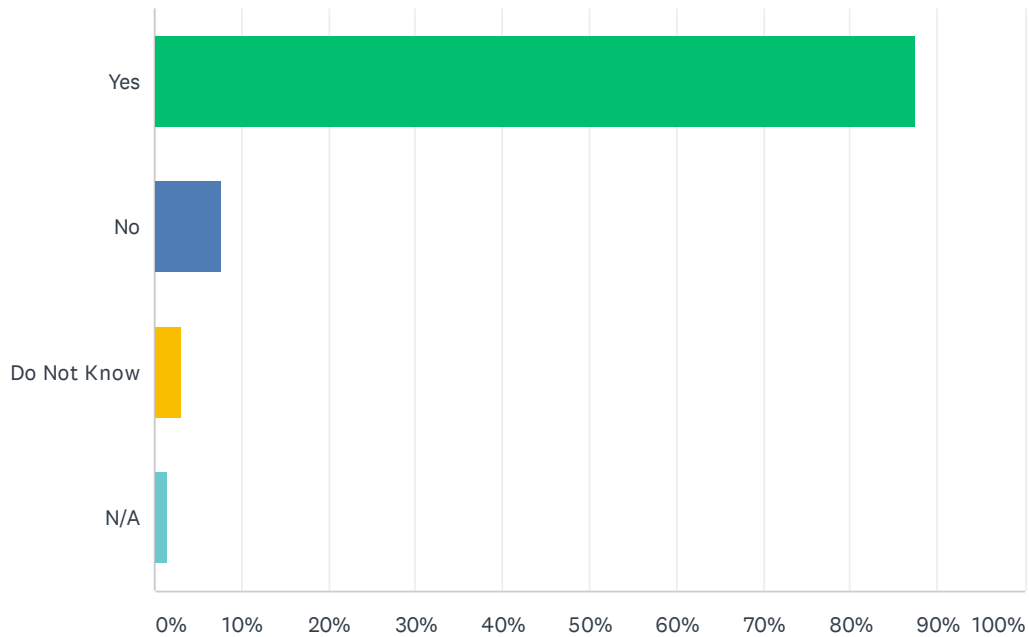

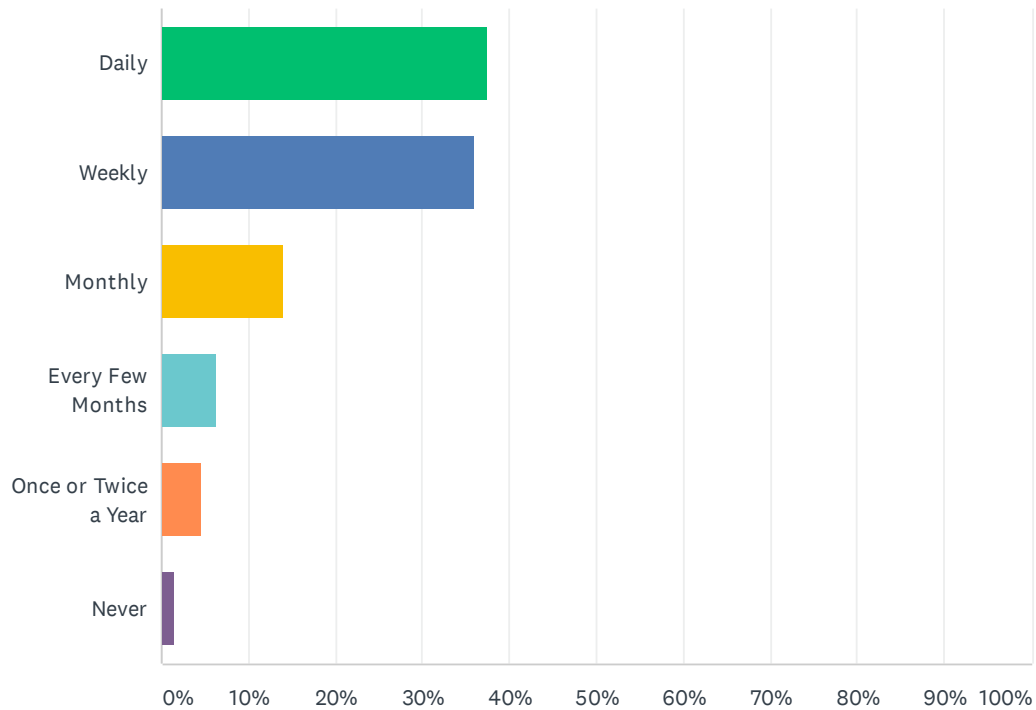

Q22 How often does your child's teacher communicate with you about your child's progress?

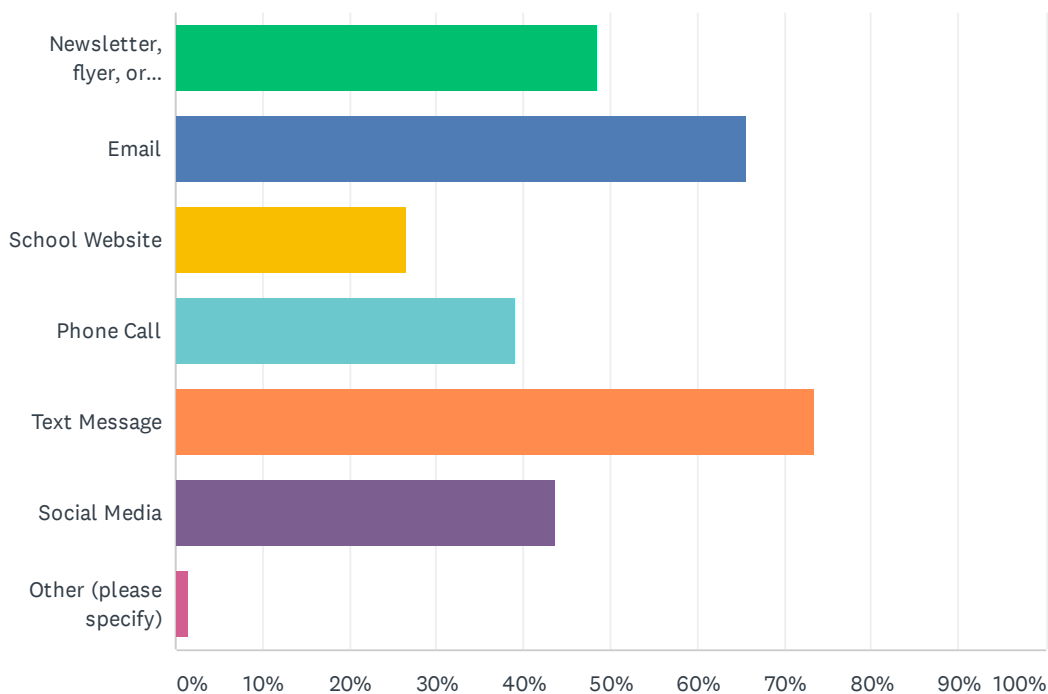

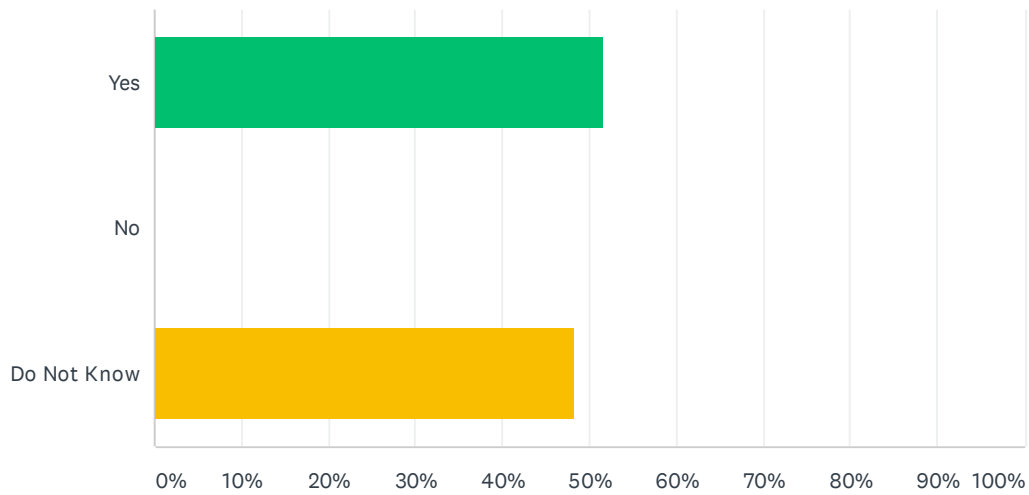

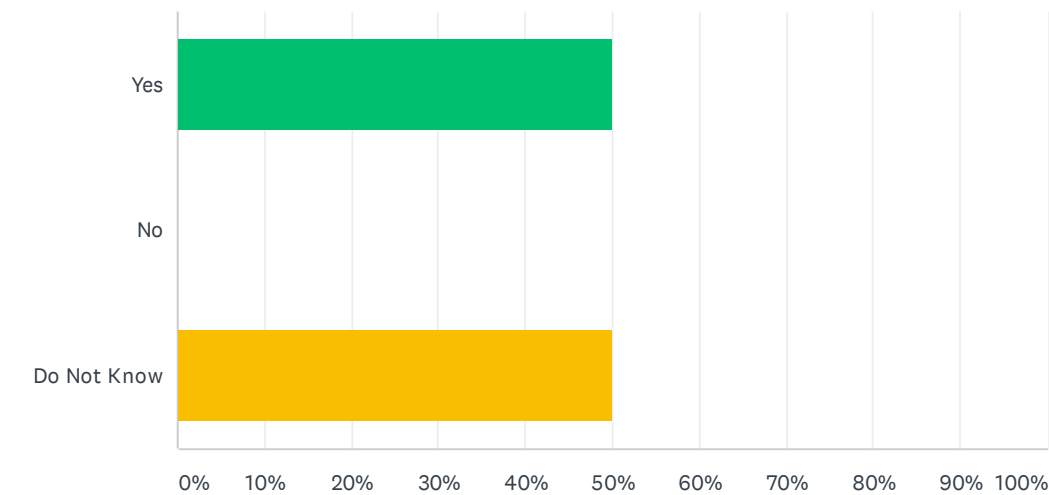

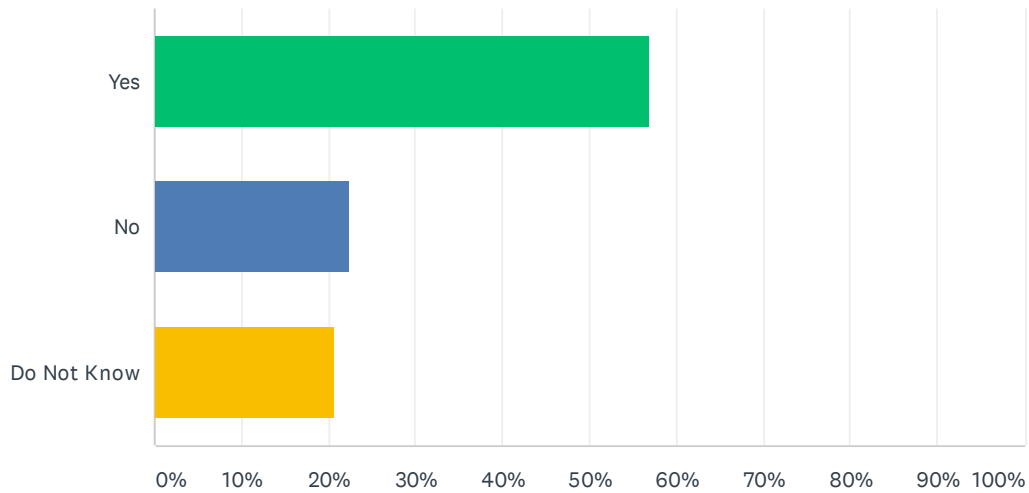

Q28 Were you aware that you may participate in the development and review of your school and district Parent and Family Engagement Plan?

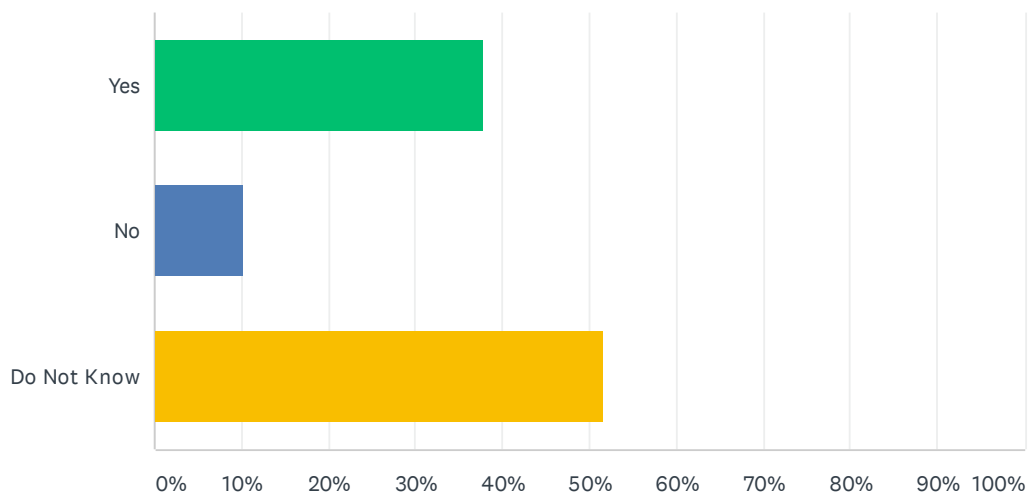

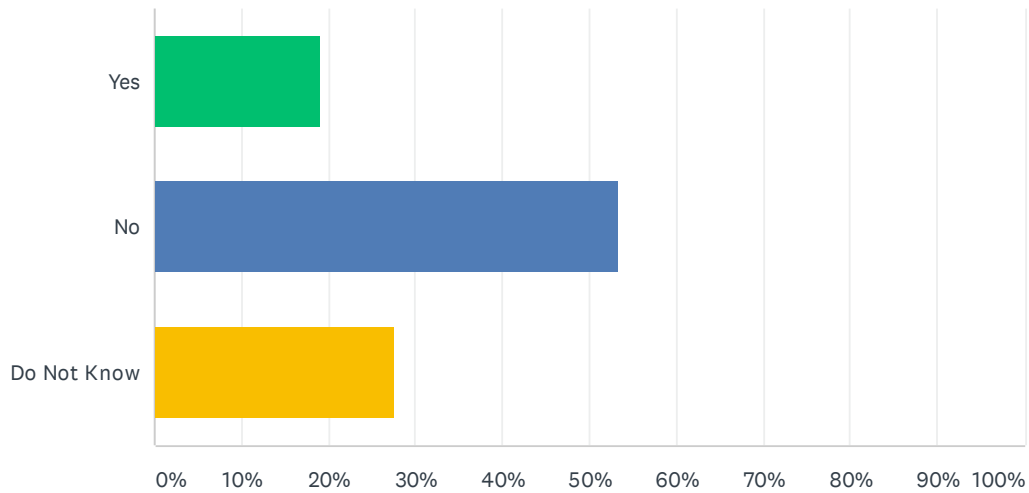

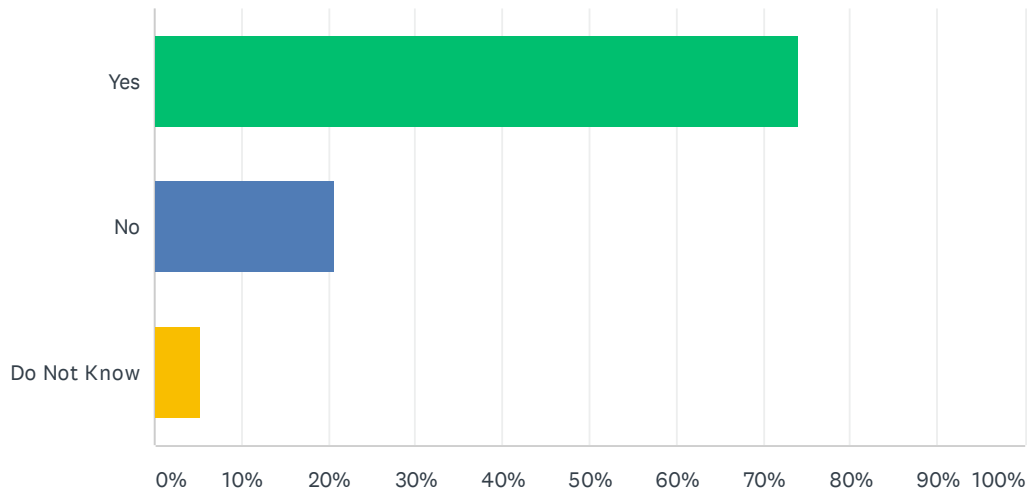

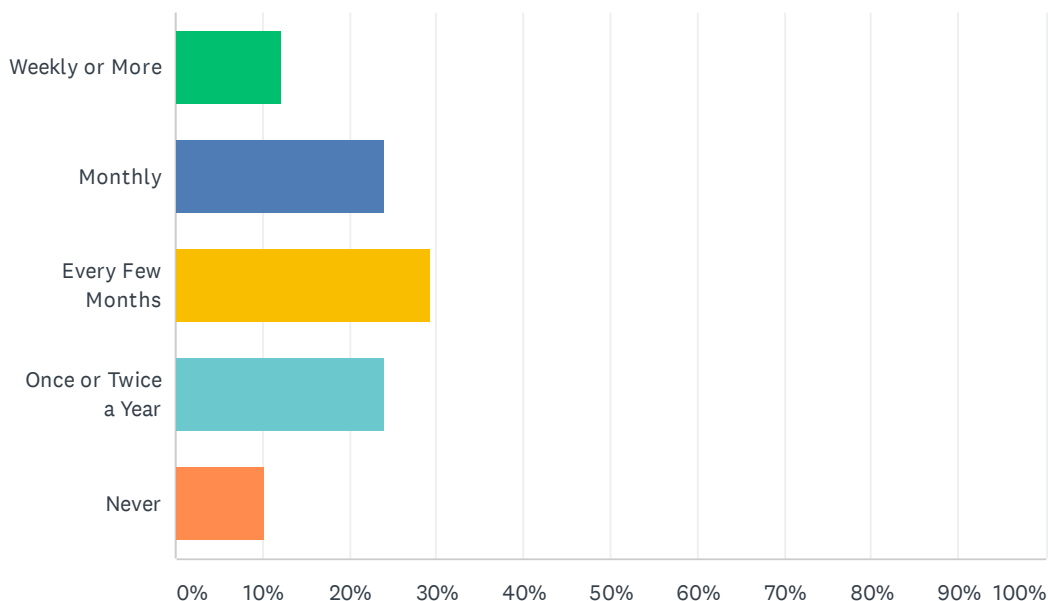

Q32 How frequently do you participate in family engagement activities or events at your child's school?

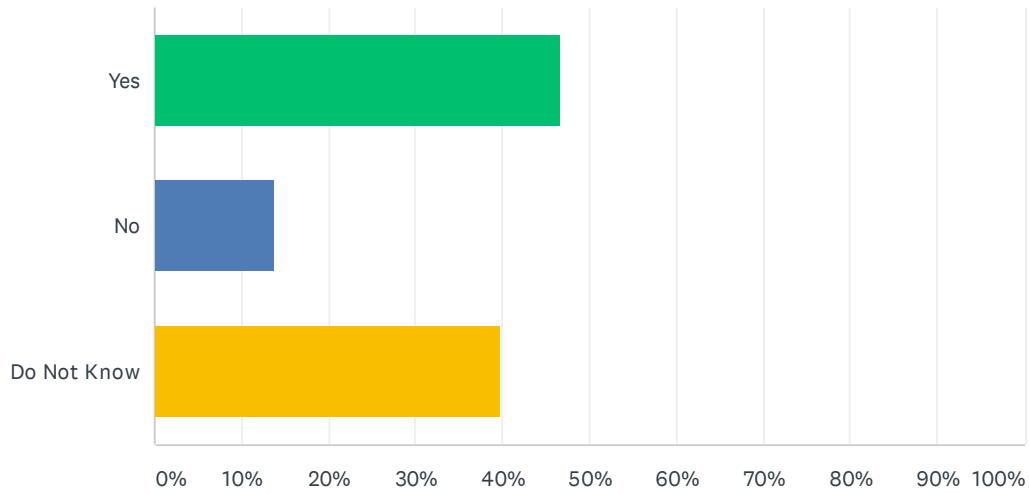

Q33 Were meetings offered at different times of the day?

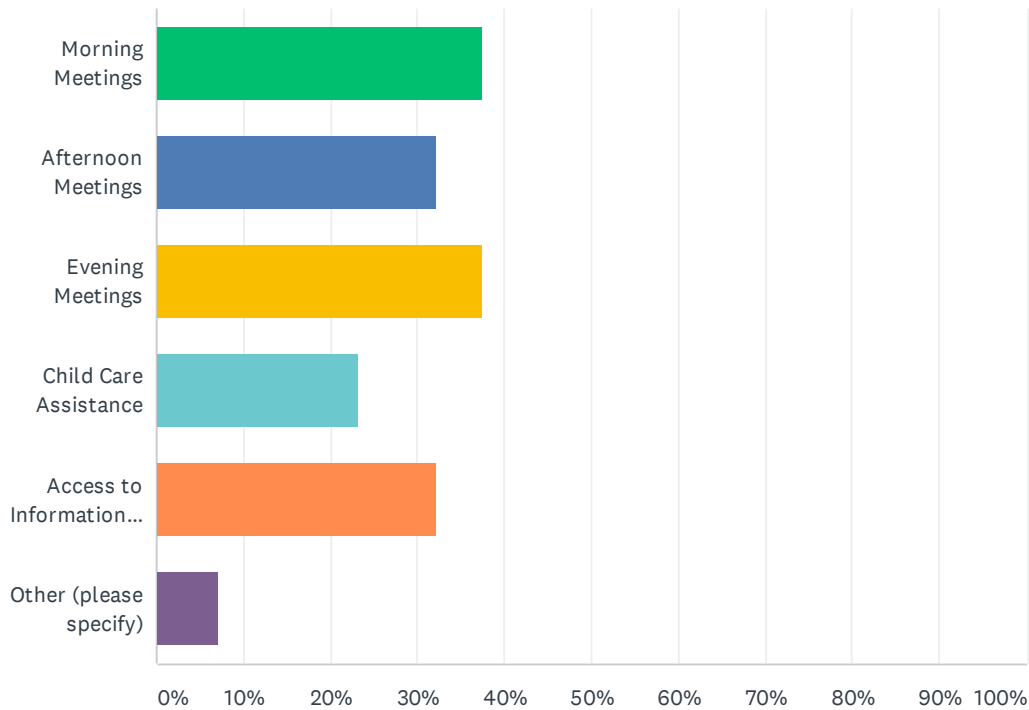

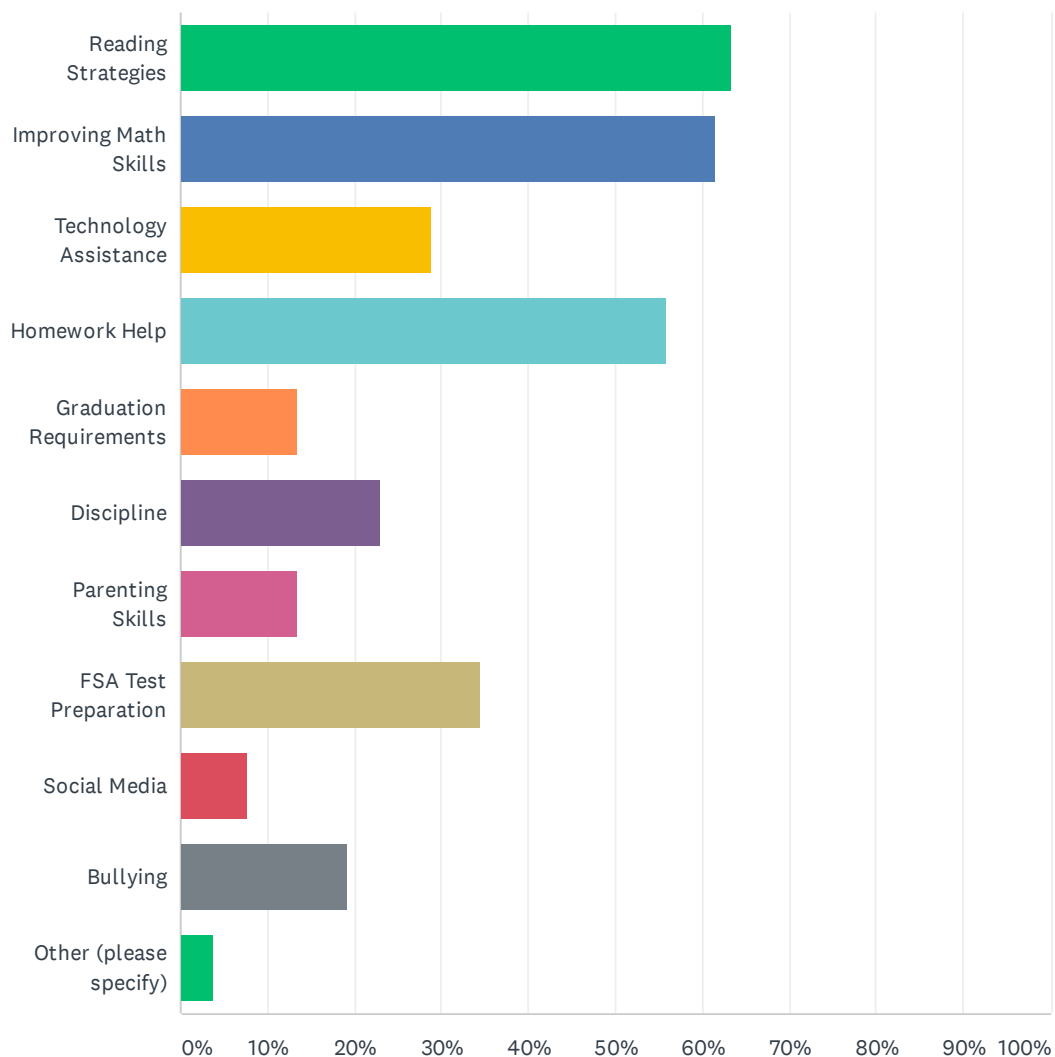
